Our triennial food packing event to provide weekend food to food-insecure elementary students in our community will be held **this Sunday, April 28 from 12:00-2:00 pm**. Sign up below to help. **A NEW WAY TO HELP** is being offered! During the month of April you will have the opportunity to choose a Food 4 Kids tag from the carousel in the narthex. The tags have varying items and donation amounts for any age to choose. For example, you might choose to donate \$1.10, the cost of one meal, or \$6.60 the cost of one ziplock bag for the weekend, or \$39.60 for the cost of 6 ziplock bags. Maybe you would

choose to buy for all our bags the peanut butter packets for \$130, or Mandarin orange fruit cups for \$156. White tags on the bottom are the smallest amounts for our youngest congregation members to be able to participate. Take one or more tags and mark your donation amount "Weekend Food Packs" either on Realm or on your check. Please note, we are not asking you to purchase the food items directly. Then, come join the fun to serve as the hands and feet of Jesus as we pack the 400 bags after church on Sunday, April 28th!

Please sign up by Monday at noon. Signup is available online (click the button below) or by calling the church office at 703-451-5120.


All those in 5th grade and older are \$7 each; 4th grade and under are free; and the family maximum is \$25. Payment is due at the door.

Breaking a Sad Record


ECHO's Food Co-Chairs report that in February, ECHO responded to food requests from 154 households within our service area. We were able to serve those families but it took more than 25,000 pounds of food, a greater total amount than we distributed per month during the first terrible months of the Covid lockdown. Food needs persist.

The Stamp Out Hunger Letter Carriers Food Drive is scheduled for Saturday, May 11. Letter Carriers from the Burke, West Springfield, and Central Springfield Post Offices will pick up bags of nonperishable food donations that residents put out at their mailboxes early in the morning on the day of the drive. Letter carriers and volunteers will bring those donations to ECHO to be sorted and shelved. This drive has proved crucial in the past to help ECHO remain stocked with food during the summer months when donations dwindle. Please watch for more information and help if you can. Even one or two items per household will make a difference. Currently, ECHO needs cereal, canned tomatoes, tomato sauce, canned meats or fish, peanut butter, crackers, shampoo, and laundry detergent.

Monday Bible Study


