



What Parents Should Know About Preschool Classes on Sundays at Westwood

*A guide to classes for babies, 1s, 2s, 3s, 4s, 5s,
and Kindergarteners*

Drop Off and Pick Up:

Drop Off for Sunday School begins at 9:40 a.m. each Sunday, and drop off for worship begins before the 11:00 a.m. service. Each child is given a numbered wristband to wear, and a corresponding numbered wristband is given to parents. When children are picked up from the preschool wing, a volunteer will check to be sure the parent and child wristbands have matching numbers before releasing the child. Parents—not siblings—should pick up their child.

What We Do:

We tell stories from the bible in creative ways and guide the kids to apply the truths to their lives. We use age-appropriate activities and crafts to reinforce the lesson. We sing songs and enjoy some free play. The only food served will be goldfish and lemonade during snack time. You are welcome to provide an alternative snack for your child and juice or water in a sippy cup. During the worship hour, we may go outside to play if the weather is nice.

About Our Volunteers:

Sunday School Teachers and Extended Session Volunteers undergo Child Protection Policy Training every other year.

What You Can Do:

After Sunday School and/or Worship, ask your child what he or she learned in class. Read the same Bible story together during the week and talk about it. Use the take home sheet to look at the Bible story pictures and retell the story. Pray for your child's Sunday School Teachers and other Preschool Volunteers this week.
