



Preschool and Children's Sunday School Parent FAQs

Drop Off and Pick Up:

Drop off for Sunday School begins at 9:40 am and for Worship before the 11:00 am service each week. If you are visiting us for the first time, we ask that you fill out a short information sheet at drop off in case we need to contact you that morning. We ask that parents, not siblings, pick up their child each morning.

What We Do:

We share stories and scripture from the Bible in creative ways and guide the kids to apply the truths to their lives. We use age appropriate activities and crafts to reinforce the lesson. We enjoy some free play and sing songs. For Preschoolers during the worship hour, we may go outside if the weather is nice.

About Our Volunteers:

Our Sunday School Teachers and Preschool Volunteers undergo our Child Protection Policy Training yearly.

What You Can Do:

After Sunday School and Worship, ask your child what they learned in class. Read the same story together at home during the week and talk about it. You can use the take home sheet to look at Bible Story pictures and retell the story. Pray for your child's Sunday School teachers and all Children's Ministry Volunteers.
